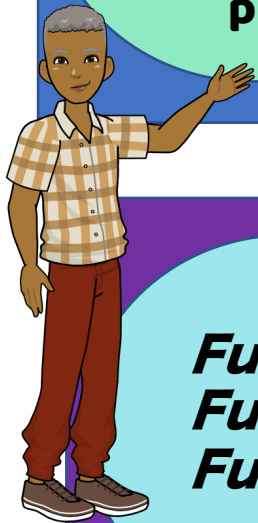


Tongue Twisters
